Introduction

In order to analyses the areas of the college and scope for further improvement, feedback from students has been received. This report focuses on the feedback of students on Study Material and Teachers' involvement and internal assessment and follow-up. Data Collection and Analysis An effort was made to receive online feedback from students of the college. For this purpose, a google form was created and circulated WhatsApp group of students from all streams. Data was collected from responses received. To arrive at comprehensive results, useful statistical tools have been used. For the effective presentation of the data, various types of graphs have been shown here.

Student Feedback on Study Material

College follows the syllabus prescribed by the university. Several questions were asked about the study material as per the syllabus. Analysis of the answers given by students is graphically presented here

1. The study material for each course is-294 responses




Chart 1 shows the response of students about the availability of course material and 80.6 percent of students agreed that sufficient material is available for the course. Almost 6.5 and 10.5 percent found it to be insufficient and challenging respectively and only 2.4 percent found it monotonous.

2. To what an extent do you get the study material for the mentioned syllabus? 294 responses




Chart 2 shows the response of students about the extent of course material they get and 71.1 percent of students agreed that sufficient material is easily available for the course. Almost 16.7 and 8.2 percent found it with difficulty and only 4.1 percent found it non available.

3. To what an extent was the study material taught in the class? 294 responses




Chart 3 shows the response of students about the extent of course material they are taught in class and 42.5 percent of students agreed that 85-100 % the course is taught in class. Almost 28.6 percent found it to around 70-85% and 21.8 percent found it to be between 55-70% and remaining 7.1 percent said it to be less than 55 percent.

4. Is it easy to understand the study material or not? 294 responses




Chart 4 shows the response of students about the understanding of study material and 60.5 percent of students found it easy to understand. Almost 22.4 percent found it to be less easy almost 13.3 % found it difficult to understand. Remaining of student found it difficult.

5. Do the teachers come with preparation for teaching? 294 responses




Chart 5 shows the response of students about the teacher's preparation for teaching. According to 63.3 percent of students say that teachers come with full preparation and 27.2 percent say it satisfactory but 5.1 percent feel its weakly. Only 4.4 % feel differently.

6. The communication of teaching is achieved-294 responses




Chart 6 shows the response of students about the communication of teaching is achieved 65 percent of students found it always effective. Almost 20.1 percent found it to be some time effective almost 11.9 percent found it only satisfactory. Only 3.1 percent feels often ineffectively.

7. To what an extent do the teachers promote participation in learning? 294 responses




Chart 7 shows the response of an extent do the teachers promote participation in learning 46.9 percent of students found it mostly time. Almost 29.6 percent found it to be always and 19.7 percent says it have some time. Only 3.7 percent feels it never do.

8. How the teachers promote participation in learning ²⁹⁴ responses



About 48 percent of students said teachers promote it through Motivation for asking question and 41.2 percent said it done by adding discussion in class room teaching. Almost 6.5 percent said, by encouraging outside and according only 4.4 percent students teachers don't encourage at all.

9. What are your views regarding library and other facilities in context with the syllabus? ²⁹⁴ responses




Chart 9 shows the response of students regarding library and other facilities and 50 percent of students found it more than required. Almost 27.6 percent found it sufficient almost 10.5 percent found in insufficient and 11.9 percent said very meagre.

10. Do you think that the college provides you with adequate sports facilities? ²⁹⁴ responses



11. Teachers' role regarding suggestions for studies is-294 responses



12. Teachers' behaviour can be interpreted as-294 responses



13. Internal assessment was-





14. According to you, internal assessment effects exam / Results ²⁹⁴ responses



15. Do teachers give Feed back to the performance of your teaching- learning? ²⁹⁴ responses



16. Are given Assignments discussed with you? 294 responses



17. What motivates you to learn more? 294 responses



18. How would you evaluate the overall academic experience in the college ²⁹⁴ responses





Are you satisfied with co-curricular activities like sports, Yuva mahotsav and participate and participate in them

OBSERVATIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. More than 80% of students agreed that sufficient material is available for the course while the remaining disagreed. Resources should be evaluated to satisfy the need of the remaining students.
- 2. About 74.5 percent of students are satisfied with sports facilities of the college, Efforts will be made by the sports department to provide better facilities to the remaining.
- 3. Large number of students accepted that study material is easy to understand, some found it not much easy and remaining found it difficult to understand. Efforts should be made by teachers for better understanding of the students.
- 4. Fine percent of students felt that teachers come to class with good preparation while a few thought otherwise. Teachers are recommended to introduce new ways.
- 5. 43.9% of students want to improve the class rooms. Hence some steps can be taken for the betterment of the classrooms within the limitation of departmental grant and resources.
